

Delinquent Payment Policy

Effective 3.1.2021

The Graymere Board of Directors hereby adopts the following policy relative to the Graymere Country Club By-Laws Section 1.7 that discuss Delinquent Payment of Dues and Assessments. Section 1.7 of the Graymere By-Laws is posted at the bottom of this page.

- 1.) Any member whose charges or assessments have not been paid within forty-five (45) days from billing date will be considered delinquent and will be notified by the Graymere staff that they are suspended from the Club.
 - **a.** If said member has been a member for over twelve (12) months the third (3rd) time said members is forty-five (45) days past due, Graymere will require them to set up automatic withdrawal from their account.
 - **b.** All new members within their first twelve (12) months of membership are required to be set up for automatic withdrawal. After the first twelve (12) months, if they have not been delinquent, they may opt-out of automatic withdrawal.

By-Law 1.7 Delinquent payment of dues and assessments. Any member whose charges or assessments have not been paid within forty-five (45) days from billing date will be considered delinquent and will be notified by the Secretary and his or her name posted within the Club building and his or her privileges will be suspended until all delinquent dues and/or assessments have been paid in full.
