Graymere Country Club – Golf Course Policies & Rules

Revised and approved by BOD 12.28.2021

The following rules have been set up by the Golf Committee and approved by the Board of Directors. We respectfully request the cooperation of all Members and their families in complying with these rules and regulations. Failure to observe the rules may make a Member liable to a fine or suspension by the Board of Directors.

Pro Shop Hours – the Pro Shop Hours will be posted in the Weekly Update Blast, and on the Website.

- 1. The Golf Pro and/or the Pro Shop Staff shall be in complete charge of the Pro Shop, Club Storage Room, Club Cleaning, Starting Times, and control of all play on the course.
- 2. The golf course is open Tuesday through Sunday to each Member, the Member's spouse or authorized significant other, the Member's children under 21 years of age, The Member's children between the ages of 21 and 24, who are full-time students, and to the Member's guests. The golf course is open only to Members and their guests on Mondays with guest registration the weekend before. Guests may play as follows:
 - (a) Guest(s) may play a maximum of three (3) rounds in season (March-October), and unlimited rounds off season (November-February).
 - (b) The above rule applies to local Guest(s) (defined as guests who reside within a 40 mile radius). Out of town guests are not subject to these limitations.
- 3. All golfers must register in the Pro Shop before commencing play.
- 4. Greens fees for eligible guest(s) will be posted in the Pro Shop. The amounts of the greens fees will be established by the Board of Directors. Greens fees and cart fees must be charged to the Host Member's account or paid via cash or credit card. Guest(s) must be accompanied by Member while playing golf, unless other arrangements are made with the Golf Professional or the General Manager.
- 5. Carts must be returned to the Pro Shop no later than ten (10) minutes prior to the golf course closing at sunset.
- 6. Carts must be kept 30 feet from tees and greens, and outside of 4x4 White Posts near greens.
- 7. In inclement weather, it may be necessary to restrict play. This determination will be made by the Golf Pro and/or the Golf Course Superintendent.
- 8. No towels belonging to the Club are to be taken on the golf course.-
- 9. For reasons of safety and courtesy and in the interest of the golf course maintenance, Members are requested to confine their practice activities to the designated areas, driving range and putting green. IMPORTANT! Practice chipping to, or putting on the regular course greens is prohibited. Please use the practice chipping green located behind the 10th green, or the putting green.
- 10. Please help us maintain your golf course by observing the following:
 - Repair all divots
 - Repair all ball marks on the greens (repair instruments are available in the Pro Shop)
 - Smooth out the Sand Bunkers (rakes are at every sand bunker and will be kept in the bunker)
 - Place cans, paper, etc. in trash cans.
- 11. Members will be held financially responsible for any damage which they, their families or their Guest(s) may inflict on greens, flagsticks, carts or other Club property.

- 12. All play will be according to USGA Rules, subject to local course rules. The local rules are posted in the Pro Shop.
- 13. All scores must be posted to establish a handicap.
- 14. **DRESS CODE:** Appropriate golf attire is required on the course.

GENTLEMEN:

Golf slacks, Bermuda and walking shorts.

Shirts must have a collar, mock neck, or turtleneck. Shirts must be tucked in at all times, and a belt must be worn.

<u>Not permitted:</u> Shirts without collars, including crew neck shirts, fish net shirts, tank tops and t-shirts. Cut-offs, athletic shorts, swim suits, tennis shorts, blue jeans and jogging attire.

LADIES:

Shirts (must have collar and/or sleeves), golf slacks, skirts, skorts, or Bermuda length shorts.

Not permitted: Halter tops, swim suit tops, revealing clothing, short shorts, cut-offs, tennis, swimming and jogging attire are not appropriate.

SHOES:

Soft Spikes, approved by the Club, are the **only cleated footwear permitted** on the course.

All headwear must be worn in a traditional bill-forward fashion.

15. Outside food and drink is prohibited.
